SV Tenacious, our tall ship, accommodates people of all ages, backgrounds and abilities. We check everyone's suitability to sail as part of our registration process and do not take anyone under the age of 16. Voyage crew must have a good understanding of the English language.

Don't worry if you haven't sailed before - no prior sailing knowledge or experience is necessary.


The Freedom to explore
